- **Pre-Announcement of a Call for International Projects in the Framework of the Era-Net Cofund Chanse.** The European association ERA-Net Cofund "Collaboration of Humanities and Social Sciences in Europe (CHANSE)" has announced that on 26th May it will open a new call for transnational projects under the theme: Improving well-being for the future. The aim of the call is to fund international collaborative research projects that promote diversity in research in different thematic priorities, including Well-being and mental. The call will be co-funded by the European

Commission and different national or regional funding agencies, including the State Research Agency.

Topic: Infectious diseases.

Organized by: European Commission.

Destination: This call is part of the European EDCTP-3 (European and Developing Countries Clinical Trials Partnership) program to fund clinical research on medical tools to detect, treat and prevent poverty-related infectious diseases in sub-Saharan Africa.

Budget: It will depend on the topic.

Quest for Cures: Collaborative Discovery Teams 2023

Topic: Cancer.

Organized by: The Brain Tumour Charity.

Destination: Grants to fund innovative pre-clinical studies in the field of brain tumours, conducted by interdisciplinary teams to support the translation of innovations into clinical practice. Teams may include researchers from any country, with preference given to those with collaborators from the UK.

Budget: up to \$1.500.000.

Duration: maximum 5 years.

Path to a Cure - Collaborative Research Grant 2023

Topic: Health.

Organized by: Cystic Fibrosis Foundation.

Destination: Grants for the financing of collaborative projects (consisting of between two and four sub-projects) that contribute to the development of new therapies or therapeutic strategies for the treatment of Cystic Fibrosis, based on the restoration of the function of the CFTR protein.

Budget: up to \$1.000.000/year.

Duration: maximum three years.

TRANSCAN-3: Joint Transnational Call for Proposals JTC 2023

Topic: Cancer.

Organized by: Carlos III Health Institute / Spanish Association Against Cancer.

Destination: Call for the funding of translational research projects in the field of cancer research, carried out by consortia made up of between three and six entities, independent of each other, belonging to at least three different countries among those participating in the call. The participation of Spanish entities in these projects will be funded by the Instituto de Salud Carlos III and the Fundación Científica de la Asociación Española Contra el Cáncer (FCAECC), and may be funded only by the ISCIII or by both entities (funding cannot be requested exclusively from the FCAECC).

Budget: by ISCIII €200.000 y €400.000 and by FCAECC €100.000 y €150.000.

Duration: maximum three years.

Deadline: 21th July 2023.

Topic: Horizon Projects.

Organized by: European Commission
